NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE SYSTEM



The National Wildlife Refuge System is administered by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge is one of more than 550 refuges in this system. The Refuge protects and manages over 47,000 acres of southern New Jersey coastal habitats, designated wilderness areas, and maritime forests.

The Wildlife Refuge system consists of units stretching across the United States from northern Alaska to the Florida Keys. It includes small islands in the Caribbean Sea and the Pacific Ocean. The character of the Refuges is as diverse as the nation itself.

Wildlife conservation drives everything on national wildlife refuges, from the purposes for which each refuge was established, to the recreational activities offered, to the resource management tools used.

Personalized Plank on our Scenic Boardwalk!

The Leeds EcoTrail is a scenic ½ mile trail through woodlands, ending with a magnificent view of the salt water marsh. The boardwalk provides an elevated view of the wetlands. There are interpretive displays about the salt water marsh. The Osprey overlook has binoculars and a panel describing the Osprey's life cycle. Both the trail and the boardwalk are handicap accessible.
